

2019-20 Junior Leadership Academy

The Junior Leadership Academy (JLA) was created by the Fort Smith Regional Chamber of Commerce and is supported by the Fort Smith regional business community. JLA is a program offered to high school juniors who desire the opportunity to learn more about the Fort Smith Region and the opportunities available in our city. You will meet community leaders from area businesses, government agencies, and civic organizations. You will be introduced into an environment designed to enhance and develop your leadership skills which will benefit you throughout the rest of your life.

Eligibility/Selection Criteria

Applicants must:

- Attend a Sebastian County High School -- you will apply as a Sophomore and complete the 20
- Demonstrate leadership and/or desire to gain strong leadership skills
- A desire to improve his/her school and community
- Have an interest in furthering his/her knowledge about Fort Smith and community leadership
- Commit to **FULL PARTICIPATION** in the Junior Leadership Academy program
- Pay the \$25.00 Program Fee. The remaining \$250.00 will be paid by local area businesses that are committed to sponsoring a student.

The JLA selection committee will be the Fort Smith Regional Chamber of Commerce Education Committee. There will be approximately 30 applicants selected for the class. Committee representatives maintain an active role during the duration of the program.

Applications will be thoroughly reviewed. Selection criteria include:

- Commitment to personal growth and desire to be successful.
- Commitment and motivation to serve the community through volunteer work
- Personal commitment to improving the community environment to favorably impact the development and quality of the community
- Strength of recommendations
- Essay briefly tell about yourself and what drives you to want to participate in this program
- Interview each applicant will be interviewed by a member of the Education Committee
- GPA of at least 2.0
- Reliable attendance history in school

The Junior Leadership Academy is looking for a very diverse class. Every student is encouraged to apply!

After all application materials have been reviewed, students will be notified if they have been selected to interview with the committee. Interviews will be tentatively held March 4 – March 15, 2019. These dates are subject to change based on school schedules. Times and locations will be announced as they are determined.

After the interviews have been completed, individual acceptance letters for those selected to JLA will be delivered to schools by April 5th, 2019. Class list will be announced through the Fort Smith Regional Chamber of Commerce social media and website as well. The official announcement to the public will be made at the New Class Reception/Orientation on May 1, 2019. YOU MUST ACCEPT YOUR POSITION IN THE CLASS BY APRIL 18, 2019 OR YOUR POSITION IN THE CLASS WILL BE FORFEITED TO AN ALTERNATE.

The sessions will be held at locations throughout the community on Wednesdays from 8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. **YOU ARE EXPECTED TO**ATTEND ALL OF THE SESSIONS, IN ADDITION TO THE RETREAT AND ANY PROGRAM ACTIVITIES. IF FOR ANY REASON YOU FEEL THAT YOU WILL BE UNABLE TO MEET THIS EXPECTATION DUE TO PARTICIPATION IN ATHLETICS, BAND, CHOIR, CHEER, DANCE, WORK, ETC. THEN YOU MAY NEED TO RECONSIDER YOUR DECISION TO APPLY FOR THE JUNIOR LEADERSHIP ACADEMY. If you have a personal emergency that requires you to miss a Junior Leadership session, you must contact the Junior Leadership Director immediately.
