

# 2020-21 Junior Leadership Academy

The Junior Leadership Academy (JLA) was created by the Fort Smith Regional Chamber of Commerce and is supported by the Fort Smith regional business community. JLA is a program offered to high school juniors who desire the opportunity to learn more about the Fort Smith Region and the opportunities available in our city. You will meet community leaders from area businesses, government agencies, and civic organizations. You will be introduced into an environment designed to enhance and develop your leadership skills which will benefit you throughout the rest of your life.

# Eligibility/Selection Criteria

#### Applicants must:

- Be a Sophomore at a Sebastian County High School
- Have a desire to improve your school & community and to gain strong leadership skills
- Have an interest in furthering his/her knowledge about Fort Smith and community leadership
- GPA of at least 2.0 and a good attendance record (no excessive absences.) This will be verified by each school.
- Both the student and a parent/guardian must sign off on the attendance policy and application.
- Essay briefly tell about yourself and what drives you to want to participate in this program
- Commit to **FULL PARTICIPATION** in the Junior Leadership Academy program. Check program dates and ensure you can attend all sessions. The Opening Retreat in August is mandatory.
- There is a minimal program fee for participation: after you are accepted into the class, we ask each student to pay \$25.00 toward the program. The remaining cost is paid by local area businesses that are graciously committed to supporting our program.

The JLA Selection Committee will be the Fort Smith Regional Chamber of Commerce Education Committee, made up of local business and community leaders. There will be approximately 30-40 applicants selected for the class. There is no set amount of students selected from each school -- it is merit-based. Applications, essays, and recommendation letters will be thoroughly reviewed. The committee will be looking for:

- Commitment to personal growth and desire to be successful.
- Motivation to serve, improve, and positively impact the quality of our community. (Don't just say you
- want things to change, how could you make it happen? If given the opportunity, how would you make a difference?
- Strength of recommendations
- Quality of Essay -- we want to hear why you want to be in this program.

Important note: we are looking for students from all walks of life, from all backgrounds, from all situations. We want students looking for a chance to be MORE, to do MORE than what they think they can. Students who want to be leaders but haven't had the opportunity yet. Students who are leaders looking to make an impact outside of their school. All are encouraged to apply!

# **Application Instructions**

The JLA Class list will be announced through the Fort Smith Regional Chamber of Commerce website and social media as well. The official announcement to the public will be made at the New Class Reception/Orientation on May 4, 2020. YOU MUST ACCEPT YOUR POSITION IN THE CLASS BY APRIL 17, 2019 OR YOUR POSITION IN THE CLASS WILL BE FORFEITED TO AN ALTERNATE.

# **Attendance Policy**

Attendance and active participation in the Junior Leadership Academy monthly sessions are essential to the success of the program. The sessions will be held at locations throughout the community on Wednesdays from approximately 7:45 a.m. – 3:45 p.m.

Transportation will be provided during the session; students are responsible for meeting the bus at either Northside High School or Southside High School at the appointed time.

YOU ARE EXPECTED TO ATTEND ALL OF THE SESSIONS, IN ADDITION TO THE RETREAT AND ANY PROGRAM ACTIVITIES. IF FOR ANY REASON YOU FEEL THAT YOU WILL BE UNABLE TO MEET THIS EXPECTATION DUE TO PARTICIPATION IN ATHLETICS, BAND, CHOIR, CHEER, DANCE, WORK, ETC. THEN YOU MAY NEED TO RECONSIDER YOUR DECISION TO APPLY FOR THE JUNIOR LEADERSHIP ACADEMY.

Every session is important for the success of your team and for your personal growth in the program. If you have a personal emergency that requires you to miss a Junior Leadership session, you must contact the Junior Leadership Director immediately. The Junior Leadership Academy is designed to be a component of your school responsibilities, as such, we are required to notify your school of any absences. Any unexcused absences may disqualify your continuation in the program. All JLA Session days are considered "school business" and should not count against your school attendance record.

Please remember that JLA is a very selective program. We always have more students apply than we can accept into the program.

We understand that you want to be involved in many activities and have many opportunities to choose from; this will be your choice to participate if selected. Participation in the Opening Retreat is <a href="REQUIRED">REQUIRED for both days</a>. If you have camps, a family vacation, or other activity that conflicts with either day of the retreat, you need to consider whether or not it will be appropriate for you to apply. There will be no exceptions made. If you miss the Opening Retreat, you will NOT be eligible to continue in the program.

Please notify the JLA Director immediately if you learn you cannot participate in JLA so that another student could possibly take your place in the program.
